MATOAKA – Noah Douglas Hawkes, 84, of Matoaka, passed away to Heaven on Tuesday, May 29, 2018 surrounded by his beloved family. Born December 29, 1933 in Matoaka, he was the son of the late Noah Columbus Hawks and Catholine Maddox Hawks.

Doug was a precious, Godly man who loved much and was loved much. He was a hard-working, Jesus loving family man and a great example to many. Doug was a lifelong member of the former Ashworth United Methodist Church in Matoaka. He served in the United States Army as a cryptographer and received the Good Conduct Medal. He worked for the United States Postal Service and retired as a postmaster in 1997 after 40 years. He spent many years in service to the church, the United Methodist Men, the Matoaka Town Council and the Matoaka Volunteer Fire Department.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two brothers, Mason and Ed; and a sister, Olga Wallace.

Survivors include his adored wife of 58 years, Shirlene Abshire Hawkes; three children, Starlene Johnson and David Johnston, Brian Hawkes and wife Debra and Carla Snyder and husband Danny all of Princeton; special brother-in-law, Gary McClung; nine grandchildren; 10 great grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.
