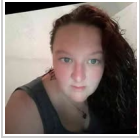
She is preceded in death by mother, Virginia Mae Carter McPherson; and grandparents, Kermit William Carter and Ethelene Meadows Carter.

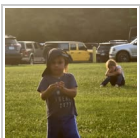
