ATHENS – After a four year battle with breast cancer, Ann Webb, 57, went to be with the Lord, with her sons, family and friends by her side, on Wednesday night, May 30, 2012. Born September 24 1954 at Welch, she was the daughter of the late Vernon Webb and Ola Gibson Webb.

Ann was an avid sports fan and loved watching her boys play sports more than anything. She spent most of her time taking her boys back and forth to practices and games and never minded cheering loudly for them and their teammates. Even in declining health, she would volunteer to work the concession stand for the PikeView Soccer Team with fundraisers and support their teams anyway she could. She was absolutely devoted to her sons. She was a 1974 graduate of Northfork High School. She had worked at Concord University Daycare. When her health permitted, she attended the Lerona United Methodist Church.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her son's father, Stanley Francisco; three sisters, Faye Kessinger, Nina Dearing and Wanda Edwards; and three brothers, Ray Webb, William Darrel Webb and James Douglas Webb.
