



## Bernice Mae Shrewsbury

September 25, 1927 - April 24, 2015

MATOAKA – Bernice Mae Shrewsbury, 87, of Matoaka, died Friday, April 24, 2015 at her home following a short illness. Born September 25, 1927 at Dott, she was the daughter of the late Philip Shrewsbury and Vercie Akers Shrewsbury.

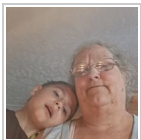
