PRINCETON – Betty Reid, 84 of Princeton died Sunday, March 8, 2020. Born September 21, 1935 in Williamson, West Virginia she was the daughter of the late Sidney Stollings and Ora Morgan Stollings.

Betty was formerly of Williamson, West Virginia where she was a charter member of Grace Baptist Temple. She retired from the Mingo County Board of Education and moved to Princeton in 1996 to be with her daughter and granddaughters. Betty was a member of Fairview Christian Community Church in Princeton where she was very active with the Care and Share Ministry. She was an avid WVU Mountaineer fan but will always be remembered as the ultimate Williamson Wolfpack fan and a true Democrat.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by her husband, James B. "Jim" Reid; one son, James "Brother" Reid and two brothers, Kenneth Stollings and Bill Stollings.
