PRINCETON – Billie Webb Morefield, 80, of Princeton, died Saturday, August 16, 2014 at GlenWood Park Retirement Village in Princeton. Born April 28, 1934 at Widemouth, WV, she was the daughter of the late Leo C. Webb and Stella B. Sutphin Webb.

Mrs. Morefield was a member of the First Baptist Church in Princeton. She retired from the Mercer County Board of Education in 1996 after 26 years of service, last serving as principal at Knob School in Princeton. She was a graduate of Matoaka High School, Concord College and received her master's degree from WV College of Graduate Studies. She was past president of the Mercer County Elementary Principals Association, Princeton Elks Ladies Golf Association and the Mercer County Retired School Employees. She was a Reach To Recovery and American Cancer Society volunteer, as well as a volunteer at Princeton Community Hospital. She was also a member of Alpha Delta Kappa, Sharecroppers Investment Organization and Princeton Elks Lodge #1459. She was an avid golfer and reader.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, James J. Morefield in 1999; one sister, Leopal Maynard; and one brother, Estel Webb.

Survivors include two daughters, Sharon Kae Belcher and her husband Jay of

Bluefield and Teena Rae Morefield of Princeton; one son, James Thomas Morefield and his wife Carolyn of Savannah, GA; two sisters, Doris Morefield and her husband Bill of Princeton and Inell Harloe of San Antonio, TX; three grandchildren, Matthew Morefield, Paige Belcher and Katherine Belcher Tierney; one great-grandson, Charles Matthew Scott Tierney; and her caregivers at GlenWood Park Retirement Village and Hospice Compassus.
