BUD – Robert Wayne “Bob” Estes, 86, of Bud, died Tuesday, November 11, 2014. Born August 4, 1928 at Bud, he was the son of the late Harry Estes and Effie Lester Estes.

Bob lived on his farm in Basin for 42 years and took pride in his garden and pond where he stocked fish and watched wildlife. In the fall he made apple butter for the fall festival at Twin Falls State Park. He was a former coal miner and enjoyed hunting, wine making and spending time with his two dogs.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Mary Ellen Wolfe Estes; three sons, Benny Estes, Patrick Estes and Barry Estes; one sister, Jessie Shrewsbury; and one brother, Patrick Henry Estes.

Survivors include two daughters, Bobbie Burrell and her husband Lenford and Tina Baisel and her husband Joseph all of Bud; two sons, Sharven Estes of Basin and Ricky Estes and his wife Marsha of Oceana; 9 grandchildren; 10 great-grandchildren; and his friends and caregivers at the nursing homes where he lived for the last two years.

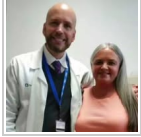
