LASHMEET – Carlos Von Shrewsbury, 88, of Lashmeet, died Sunday, December 25, 2011 at Princeton Community Hospital. Born November 11, 1923 on Arista Mountain, he was the son of the late William Martin and Martha Susan Akers Shrewsbury.

Mr. Shrewsbury was retired from Eastern Associated Coal Corp. at Herndon and was a member of UMWA Local Union 9781. He was a veteran of the US Navy having served in the Pacific Theater during World War II on the USS Shea, USS Alfred J. Lyons, SS Albert Hill and SS Sea Porpoise. He received the Pacific Theater, American Theater and Philippine Liberation Ribbons, along with the Victory Medal. Carlos loved life and lived to serve his Lord, family and friends.
