ROCK – Carnis Harold Delp, 91, of Rock, died Tuesday, July 24, 2018. Born August 29, 1926 at Fireco, he was the son of the late Freelon Brown Delp and Hettie Huffman Delp.

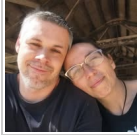
