PRINCETON – Carol Butler, 83, of Princeton, died Friday, April 6, 2018. Born August 30, 1934 at Welch, she grew up in the community of Marytown, WV. She was the daughter of the late George Washington Phillips and Ora Walker Phillips.

Mrs. Butler was a graduate of Welch High School and moved to Princeton to work at the Maidenform plant. She later worked at Hill's Department Store for many years. Her father was a coal miner in the McDowell County surrounding areas mines and her mother died when she was 11 years old. She is last surviving member of her immediate family. She loved gardening and taking care of her house, watching mystery movies on TV, reading magazines, making flower arrangements and baking for friends and family.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by eleven siblings.

Survivors include her daughter, Sharon Sullivan of Pilot Mountain, NC; two grandsons, Nathan and Spencer Sullivan; nieces and nephews, Jack Vance of Virginia and Joe Vance and Mary Garcia both of North Carolina; and special friends, Mike and Linda Kessler of Princeton.
