



Cecil Shrader

October 23, 1925 - December 7, 2015

PRINCETON – Cecil Carr Shrader, 90, of Princeton, died Monday, December 7, 2015. Born October 23, 1925 at Sandlick, he was the son of the late Royal Jennings Shrader and Pearl Grace Murrell Shrader.

Mr. Shrader was a veteran of the US Army. He was retired from Norfolk Southern Railroad and was a member of the Sandlick United Methodist Church where he taught Sunday School for more than 30 years. He enjoyed fishing, gardening and reading his Bible.


