MATOAKA – Charlie Thomas Nesbit, 93, of Matoaka, died Tuesday, February 24, 2015 at Princeton Community Hospital. Born May 31, 1921 at Weyanoke, he was the son of the late Richard Nesbit and Mary Edith Bell Nesbit.

Mr. Nesbit was a member of Ashworth Memorial Methodist Church in Matoaka and a former member of Matoaka Baptist Church and Shawnee Baptist Church where he served as a deacon and Sunday School teacher. He was a member of the Matoaka Kiwanis Club and the Lashmeet Ruritan Club. He was a retired coal miner and a member of the UMWA. He was an avid outdoorsman and ginsenger.

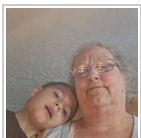
