BLUEFIELD – Dacer Dale Shrewsbury, 91, of Bluefield, died Friday, July 12, 2024. Born August 19, 1932 in Lamar, he was the son of the late Kay Vivian Shrewsbury and Thelma James Davis Shrewsbury.

Mr. Shrewsbury enlisted in the US Army in 1949 and served in the Korean War. He retired from National Coil in Bluefield. He was a member of Rocky Gap Methodist Church. He was also a member of the Fraternal Order of Moose and Eagles. He enjoyed playing pool and watching WVU football.
