MATOAKA – Danny Charles Vickers "Charlie Brown", 43, of Matoaka, died Wednesday, March 6, 2013 at his home. Born April 15, 1969 at Princeton, he was the son of Carolyn S. McKnight of Norwich, CT.

Danny lived in the Matoaka area all his life. He was a hard worker and everyone knew him. He never knew a stranger. He is now free from pain – no more sorrow. He was of the Baptist faith and loved his Lord. He attended Lashmeet/Matoaka school. For years he worked for the Asplundh Tree Co. and for Pounding Mill Rock Quarry in Oakvale. He loved his work and his co-workers. He and his wife, Debra, celebrated their 13th wedding anniversary on January 28 and were together for 18 years.

In addition to his mother, survivors include his wife of 13 years, Debra McIntosh Vickers of Matoaka; one brother, Jonathan McKnight of Matoaka; step-maternal grandfather, John Vickers of Princeton; a step-daughter, Chrystal Dickerson and her husband Daniel of Princeton; and two grandchildren, Bailey A.
