BLUEFIELD, VA – Donna Louise Cameresi, 55, of Bluefield, VA, passed away peacefully on Saturday, January 10, 2026, with her family by her side. Born November 9, 1970, in Princeton, she was the daughter of the late Donald Ray Law and Frances Louise Jenkins Law.
