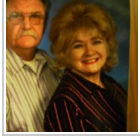

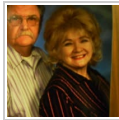

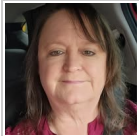

I soon won all \$20 he had and I felt bad for him because he was so depressed. I offered him his money back but his pride would not let him take it. I soon after left for the Air Force so fast forward about 18 months when I was home on leave. I ran into Eanon outside the grocery store where I think he was working and was on his lunch break. He challenged me some 8 ball and I agreed so he took me upstairs in the Moose Lodge and heartlessly took me for the original \$20 plus another \$40 or so. I will never forget that huge smile he had on his face. That was a lot of money for a GI back then so he offered it back to me as I did him before. Of course I couldn't take it.

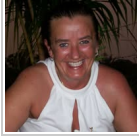
