PRINCETON - Earl Wayne "Red" Haga, 80, of Princeton died Thursday, February 18, 2016. Born February 14, 1936, in Wyoming County, he was the son of the late William Roosevelt Haga and Mary Ines Walls Haga.

Wayne was faithful to the Lord and loved his wife and family. He was a partner in Persinger and Company, LLC prior to his retirement and was a member of the Virginia Society of Certified Public Accountants and the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants.
