WINCHESTER, KY – Eunice Eloise Crotty Myers, 88, of Winchester, KY, formerly of Princeton, died Monday, October 11, 2010 in Winchester, KY. Born February 15, 1922 in Princeton, and a life-long resident there until recently, she was the eldest of nine children born to the late Opia Calfee Crotty and Vera Langford Crotty.

She was an active member of First Baptist Church in Princeton for more than 65 years, serving in many of its ministries, especially its missionary and outreach programs. She also taught children in Sunday School, Training Union, and Vacation Bible School for many years.
