



## Emmett Hatfield

May 13, 1935 - February 2, 2024

PRINCETON – Emmett Hatfield, 88, of Princeton, died Friday, February 2, 2024. Born May 13, 1935 in Gilbert, he was the son of the late Sidney and Tilda Hatfield.

Emmett was a member of the Pentecostal House of Praise in Princeton. He was a retired coal miner and a member of the UMWA. He enjoyed hunting, fishing and riding ATVs. He loved his family and his church family. Emmett was known by some of his friends as “Cowboy.”
