



Floyd "Randy" Kegley

January 31, 1931 - January 1, 2014

PRINCETON – Floyd R. “Randy” Kegley, 82, of Princeton, died Wednesday, January 1, 2014 at Beckley Veterans Hospital. Born January 31, 1931 at Gratton, VA, he was the son of the late Floyd J. Kegley and Clara Mae Etter Kegley.

Mr. Kegley was a member of Immanuel Baptist Church in Princeton where he was assistant Sunday School teacher for 10 years and was a member of the choir. He was a former employee of Blankenship Gulf Service Station and Garage in Matoaka for 30 years. He worked for four years at a Buick Dealership in Washington, DC. 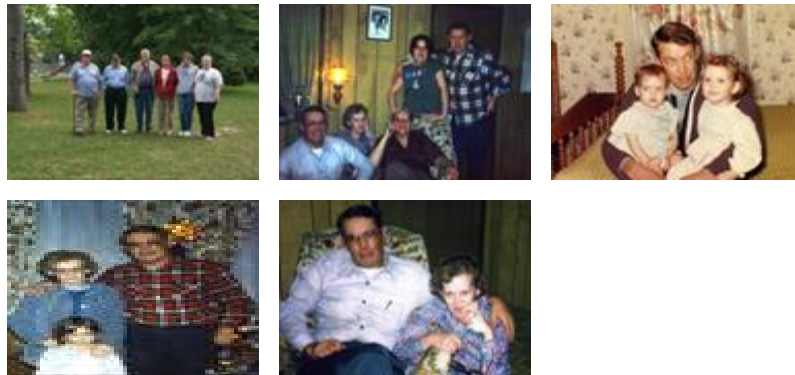
