



## Franklin Delano Wiley

March 9, 1942 - February 26, 2015

PRINCETON – Franklin Delano Wiley, 72, of Princeton, died Thursday, February 26, 2015 at Princeton Community Hospital. Born March 9, 1942 at Kegley, he was the son of the late Thomas Wiley and Mattie Blankenship Wiley.

Mr. Wiley was a very active member of the Matoaka Baptist Church and the Shawnee Baptist Church where he served as a deacon and was an Adult Sunday School Class teacher. One of his favorite things to do was visit sick members and shut-ins of the church. He was a veteran of the United States Marine Corps having served for 4 years. He spent the majority of his working career as an electrician before he was a senior salesman at United Industrial Services.
