HIAWATHA – Fred Robert Gross, 83, of Hiawatha, died Wednesday, October 26, 2016. Born March 19, 1933 at Dott, he was the son of the late William Gross and Ivory Taylor Gross.

Fred was a veteran of the U.S. Army. He worked as a coal miner for 12 years. He was a former employee of Eastern Stairbuilders in Baltimore, Maryland. 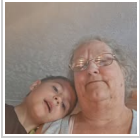
