



Fred Sanders

September 20, 1932 - November 17, 2014

PRINCETON - Fred Sanders, 82, of Princeton, died Monday, November 17, 2014 at his home. Born September 20, 1932 at Kegley, he was the son of the late Basil Sanders and Mary Myrtle Reed Sanders

Mr. Sanders was a veteran of the US Navy for four years during the Korean Conflict. He attended Barber School in Philadelphia, PA and opened a barbershop with his brother and operated it for 47 years. Upon retirement, he returned to Princeton. He was a member of Fairview Christian Community Church in Princeton for eleven years where he was an active member of the Men's Prayer Group.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by one sister, Mary Ann Joyce; and three brothers, Oral D. Sanders, Otis Z. Sanders and Randal B. Sanders.

He is survived by his wife of 59 years, Katie Boles Sanders; two sons, Doug Sanders and his wife Kathy of Holland, PA and Fred Sanders and Diane Brodie of Levittown, PA; one daughter, Cindy Stone and her husband Bill of Glendive, MT; one brother, Larry D. Sanders of Tucson, AZ; eight grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.
