



## Freddie J. Harvey

April 15, 1945 - November 10, 2016

PRINCETON – Freddie J. Harvey, 71, of Princeton died Thursday, November 10, 2016 at Princeton Community Hospital. Born April 15, 1945 at Princeton he was the son of the late William Harvey and Gladys Dinger Harvey.

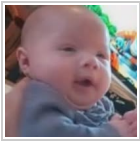

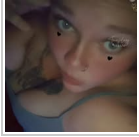
