PRINCETON- Garlain Shrewsbury, 94, of Princeton Health Care Center, Courthouse Road, Princeton formerly of the Beckley Road in Princeton passed away peacefully early Monday, February 16, 2015. Born November 19, 1920 at Wenonah Mountain, Dott, he was the son of the late William Henderson Shrewsbury and Arminta Elizabeth Shrewsbury.

Garlain was a farmer at an early age and continued throughout his nineteen years as a coal miner in the mountains of Dott. He established a job with Jo Anna Western in Chicago, IL and years later retired from the city of Mt. Rainier, MD.
