PRINCETON – Grover Franklin Woody, 80, of Princeton died Tuesday, June 11, 2013 at Wake Forest Baptist Hospital in Winston Salem, NC. Born May 21, 1933 at Montcalm he was the son of the late Arthur M. Woody and Oka Hayter Woody.
