LASHMEET – Harold Lloyd Burkett, 85, of Lashmeet, died Monday, November 4, 2019. Born December 6, 1933 at Piedmont, he was the son of the late Glen Burkett and Havanah Davis Burkett.

Harold served in the U.S. Army from July 1953 until June 1956. He worked most of his life for Skyline Motors and Heritage/Friendly Honda, where he retired approximately 20 years ago.
