PRINCETON – Harry Lee Mann, 91, of Princeton, died Monday, June 1, 2026. Born June 19, 1934, in Greenville, he was the son of the late Wilbur Mann and Esther Carte Mann.

Harry was a veteran of the US Navy. He retired from the Pompano Beach Fire Department in Florida and Industrial Gas and Supply in Bluefield. He served as Sunday School Superintendent and deacon at Mt. Jackson Baptist Church in Athens for many years. He was current member of Cooks Chapel Baptist Church in Pipestem.
