PRINCETON – Harvey Kent (Jack) Tibbs, Sr., 85, of Princeton, died Thursday, July 12, 2012 at Princeton Community Hospital. Born July 1, 1927 at Portsmouth, OH, he was the son of the late Herbert Kent Tibbs and Daisy Hearn Tibbs.

Mr. Tibbs was a graduate of Welch High School and received his B.S. degree from Concord College where he was a member of Blue Key National Honor Fraternity. He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy. He had been a resident of Princeton for 34 years. He was a member of First Baptist Church in Princeton where he served as a deacon, Sunday School teacher, choir member and served on many church committees. He was a public accountant in Princeton and was a comptroller at Princeton Bank and Trust for several years.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by one sister, Phyllis Choate.
