LASHMEET ❖❖ Hazel Angles Hill Folden, 88, of Lashmeet died Sunday, April 13, 2014 at Princeton Community Hospital. Born June 23, 1925 in Tazewell, Virginia, she was the daughter of the late John Preston Angles and Ida Blanch Bailey Angles.

Mrs. Folden was the last surviving member of her family. She was a member of the Deliverance Temple Church in Brushfork and loved gospel music and gospel groups. She was employed as a telephone operator in Tazewell, worked at Hershey's in Pennsylvania, and during World War II was Rosey the Riveter in Flint, Michigan. Throughout most of her life she was a homemaker.

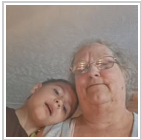
