



## Hazel Stovall

May 10, 1929 - July 23, 2014

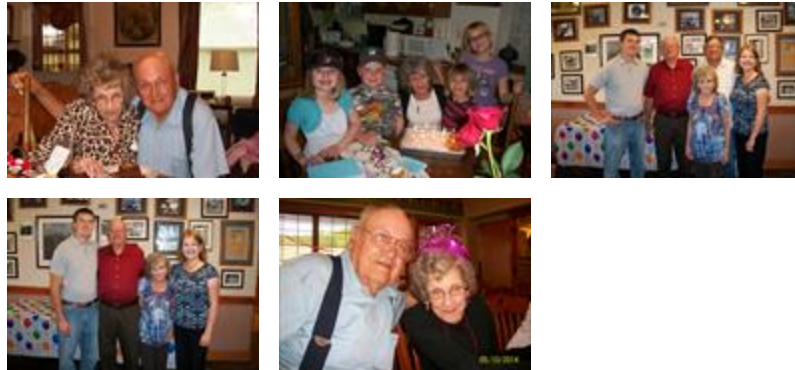
