



## Lt. Col. Henry "Tom" Cook

January 31, 1927 - December 3, 2017

NORFOLK, VA – Lt. Col. Henry “Tom” Cook (USMC Ret.), 90, passed away Sunday, December 3, 2017. Born January 31, 1927 in Roanoke, VA, he was the son of the late Roy and Goldie Cook.

Tom dedicated 25 years of his life to serving in the United States Marine Corp and served in World War II, the Korean Conflict and the Vietnam War. He received the Award of the Republic of Vietnam Armed Forces Meritorious Citation of Gallantry Cross with Palm for his service. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Norfolk, the NRA and Marine Corp Association. Tom attended Wesleyan University, Princeton University, Concord College and the University of Michigan.
