PRINCETON – Irene Angove, 88, of Princeton, died Friday, November 14, 2014 at Princeton Community Hospital. Born June 21, 1926 at Marfrance, WV, she was the daughter of the late Andy Boyd and Hettie Boyd Boyd.

Mrs. Angove had been a member of First Baptist Church in Princeton since 2002 and was a former member of First Baptist Church in Keystone. She was a former employee of G.C. Murphy Co. in Northfork.
