



## Jack Archer

May 30, 1941 - June 29, 2019

PRINCETON – Jackie Lee (Jack) Archer, 78, of Princeton, passed away at his home Saturday, June 29, 2019, after a 13-year battle with cancer. Born May 30, 1941, Jack was the son of the late Snowdie and Ruth Wimmer Archer.

He was a former employee of Eastern Associated Coal Company Keystone #1 and the former co-owner of Fred & Jack's Auto Salvage.
