LASHMEET – Oscar Jack Bailey, 89, of Lashmeet, died Friday, January 7, 2022. Born August 9, 1932 in Beartown, he was the son of the late Oley Bailey and Myrtle Short Bailey.

Jack was a veteran of the US Army, having served from 1952-1954. After serving his country, he spent most of his career working for Consolidation Coal. He was a faithful member of Maranatha Baptist Church in Princeton and loved his Lord and Savior.
