PRINCETON – James G. Nelson, 77, of Princeton, died Monday, May 24, 2021. Born October 28, 1942 in Oakvale, he was the son of the late Harry Gilbert Nelson and Edna Mae Walls Nelson.

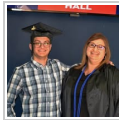
