LAWRENCEVILLE, GA – John Henry Hagy, 89, of Lawrenceville, GA, formerly of Princeton, WV, went to be with the Lord on January 19, 2026. Born August 17, 1936, in Gary, WV, he was the son of the late Henry Hagy and Georgia Stone Hagy.

A devoted Christian, Mr. Hagy honorably served his country as a veteran of the United States Air Force.
