BLUEFIELD – John Paul Siebenhaar, Sr., 81, of Bluefield, died Monday, May 13, 2024. Born November 30, 1942 in Chicago, IL, he was the son of the late Christian John Siebenhaar and Sophia Elizabeth Paulus Siebenhaar.

Mr. Siebenhaar was a veteran of the US Army, having served in Germany during the Vietnam War era. He was a professional welder in the industrial, manufacturing and aerospace sectors.
