



Kathy Jean Tabor

January 18, 1965 - February 13, 2024

PRINCETON – Kathy Jean Tabor, 59, of Princeton, died Tuesday, February 13, 2024. Born January 18, 1965 in Princeton, she was the daughter of Douglas Midkiff and Eunice Jean Caldwell Midkiff of Princeton.

Kathy was the co-founder of the A.L.I.V.E. Animal Services Group in Princeton. She was a dedicated animal advocate who served the community and the animals who were at risk, neglected, abused or injured. She was a proponent of spay and neuter ordinances aimed to help curb the overpopulation of animals, resulting in unwanted litters and euthanasia.

Survivors include her husband of 34 years, Steve Tabor; and special friend, Leisa Moten of Pipestem.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2:00 p.m. Saturday, February 17, 2024 at the Bailey-Kirk Funeral Home in Princeton with Rev. Larry Dyer and Rev. Blake Bivens officiating. Interment will be at 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, February 21, 2024 at Roselawn Memorial Gardens in Princeton.

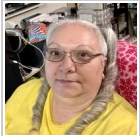

When I had knee surgery in 2014 Nova was sick she came by my house and took Nova to ACC and brought her back.

My mind is running over with things Kathy Tabor and A.L.I.V.E did to help me. We have lost a valuable animal advocate. Rainbow Bridge babies were waiting on her.
