LASHMEEET – Larry Clayton McGuire, 74, of Lashmeet, died Thursday, November 28, 2013 in Beckley. Born March 20, 1939 at Lebanon, VA, he was the son of the late Harmon McGuire and Mayme Musick McGuire.

Mr. McGuire served in the U.S. Army in Hawaii. He moved to Chicago and worked for a heavy equipment manufacturer. Upon returning to West Virginia in 1972, he became a licensed contractor for 36 years. He loved the outdoors and working in his garden. He enjoyed hunting, fishing and cutting wood.
