PRINCETON – Larry K. Murdock, 84, of Princeton, died Tuesday, April 30, 2024. Born September 25, 1939 in Lively, WV, he was the son of the late Carl Dennis Murdock and Erma Lorene Phipps Murdock.

Larry was a 1957 graduate of Mount Hope High School and served in the US Air Force for nine years. He worked as a surface coal mine inspector for MSHA for over 20 years, and was a bus driver for Bluefield Area Transit for ten years.

Larry was dedicated to serving the Lord. He was a member of Laurel Grove Baptist Church in Lively and later became a member of Willowbrook Baptist Church in Princeton, where he served as a deacon.
