PRINCETON – Lawrence Bee "Larry" Showalter, Jr., of Princeton, died Sunday, September 2, 2012. Born July 31, 1948 in Princeton, he was the son of Kathryn Kessinger Showalter of Princeton and the late Lawrence Bee "Pete" Showalter, Sr.

Mr. Showalter was a 1967 graduate of Princeton High School. He served in the US Navy for 10 years including tours of duty in Vietnam and Korea. He was a submarine sonar technician and did general submarine sonar maintenance and was a sonar supervisor. He was a very faithful member of the Cornerstone Family Church in Princeton.

In addition to his father, he was preceded in death by one brother, Brian Lee Showalter.
