GREEN VALLEY– Lennie Ray Zade, 63, of Green Valley, died Wednesday, March 23, 2011 at his home. Born July 4, 1947 at Smith Center, KS, he was the son of Carl E. Zade of Sacramento, California and the late Louise Delores Tuxhorn Zade Whealton.

Mr. Zade was a disabled Vietnam Veteran. He has called West Virginia home since 2005, living most of his life in Sacramento, CA. He received the Bronze Star Medal, Purple Heart, National Defense Service Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Ribbon W/Device, Expert Badge and Marksman Badge.

In addition to his mother, he was preceded in death by step-father, William Whealton; step-mother, Casey Zade; and a son, Shannon Zade.

Survivors include his wife of 29 years, Deanna Carol Akers Zade; a step-son, Chris J. Aguilar of Sacramento, CA; three brothers, Terry Zade and his wife Denise, Lewis Zade and his wife Terrell and Ricky Zade; two sisters, Carlotta Zimmerman and her husband Carl and Patricia Knight and her husband

James; father-in-law and mother-in-law, Walton V. Akers and Emma Dean Thomason Akers; and many beloved nieces, nephews and friends.

In keeping with Lennie's wishes his body was cremated. A memorial service will be conducted at a later date and burial will be at Monte Vista Park Cemetery at Green Valley.
