PRINCETON – Lonnie Woodrow Walker, 82, of Princeton, died Wednesday, May 24, 2023. Born December 30, 1940 in Pinoak, he was the son of the late Kerney Walker and Margaret Nicholson Walker.

Mr. Walker was a top salesman for Raleigh Products for many years. He was a veteran of the National Guard and the US Army and participated in a secret mission in Vietnam. He also worked with a children's hospitals in Germany. After retiring from the Army, he owned and operated a produce market in Marion, Virginia. He also transported mobile homes and refurbished apartments. He was a member of the Pentecostal Revival Center in Princeton. Mr. Walker was an artist and a musician who could play many instruments.
