

Mason Wiley

March 21, 1944 - February 20, 2016

PRINCETON – Charles Mason Wiley, 71, of Princeton, died Saturday, February 20, 2016. Born March 21, 1944 at Kegley, he was the son of the late Thomas T. Wiley and Mattie Oma Blankenship.

Mr. Wiley had been a resident of Richmond, Virginia for 38 years where he retired from Colonial Pipeline in 1999 with 35 years of service. For the last 17 years he resided in Pipestem and recently moved to Princeton. He was an active member of Rich Creek Baptist Church in Spanishburg.

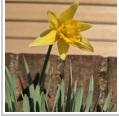
