PRINCETON – Oma L. Slone, 101, of Princeton, formerly of Matoaka, died Tuesday, May 21, 2019 with her family by her side. Born February 12, 1918 in Kegley, she was the daughter of the late Matthew “Doc” Walker and Beulah Brown Walker.
