June 28, 1936 - December 16, 2022

LASHMEET – Perry Vest, 86, of Lashmeet, went home to be with the Lord on Friday, December 16, 2022 at PHCC surrounded by his family. Born June 28, 1936 in Matoaka, he was the son of the late Walter Vest and Maude Hanks Vest.

Mr. Vest attended Matoaka High School and enlisted in the US Army serving in the Korean War. After the Army he worked for Ford Motor Company in Detroit, Michigan, followed by several years as a West Virginia coal miner.

He was of the Baptist faith and attended Shawnee Baptist Church in Kegley. He enjoyed singing in church, camping, hunting, attending the WV State Fair, eating at McDonald's and riding with his buddy Cody looking for deer and turkey.

Perry was the last surviving member of his immediate family. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his first wife of 41 years, Lillie Holbrooks Vest; second wife of seven years, Pansy Taylor Vest; and siblings, Alma, Amos, Joe, Mae, Marie, Marion and Roy.
