



Ralph Lusk

December 12, 1945 - January 27, 2021

PRINCETON – Ralph E. Lusk, 75, of Princeton, passed away Wednesday, January 27, 2021 in a one car accident. Born December 12, 1945 at Horse Creek, he was the son of the late Robert (Bob) Lusk and Mary Belle Mullens Lusk.

Mr. Lusk was a veteran of the US Army having served in Vietnam. He was a retired coal miner with 40 years underground and was a member of UMWA Local 1503. He enjoyed playing guitar and “piddling.”
