



Ramona Elleane Godfrey

December 18, 1931 - November 26, 2013

PRINCETON – Ramona Elleane Godfrey, 81, formerly of Princeton died Tuesday, November 26, 2013 at Mercer Nursing and Rehab Center in Bluefield. Born December 18, 1931 in Sullivan, she was the daughter of the late Benjamin C. Farley and Maude E. Lusk Farley.

Ramona was of the Southern Baptist faith and attended Sweet Home Regular Baptist Church in Princeton. She had resided in Princeton since 1978, having returned to the area from Michigan. She worked as a medical billing clerk for Southern Highlands Mental Health Center in Princeton for 20 years. Ramona enjoyed having lunch and playing bingo at the Mercer County Senior Center.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by two brothers, Hobert Frank Farley and Benjamin Caudill Farley and one sister, Alice Victoria “Tooter” Farley Dillon.
