MATOAKA - Rema Faye Shrewsbury Blankenship, 90, passed away at her home in Matoaka on August 27, 2016 surrounded by family. Born on August 31, 1925 in Amigo, WV she was the daughter of the late Wiley Shrewsbury and Gracie Shrewsbury Blankenship.

Rema graduated from Stoco High School at Lego and was employed at the Turkey Gap Coal and Coke Company at Dott before marrying her husband Charles E. Blankenship in December 1946. Rema was a member of the Ashworth Memorial United Methodist Church in Matoaka for over 65 years and enjoyed singing in the choir there. Rema lived a Christian life, serving her Lord and Savior. She loved everyone she knew and would help anyone with anything she could. Her faith was tested when she lost her only son, Charles Howard.
